

TELL CONGRESS: Trump has bombed six boats coming from Venezuela, taken two people prisoner, and, now, is escalating threats to start ground strikes. Last week, Trump launched airstrikes against a SIXTH boat from Venezuela that the White House claimed carried so-called "narco-terrorists." And for the first time amidst these strikes, the Trump administration took two prisoners from the boat.¹

Now, Trump is escalating threats to start a ground war, saying, "We are certainly looking at land now, because we've got the sea very well under control." He's even authorized the CIA to carry out lethal operations in Venezuela.

Senators Adam Schiff, Tim Kaine, and Rand Paul are leading the charge to force a vote to block Trump from starting a full-blown ground war with Venezuela.⁴ The last vote to check Trump's war powers came just three votes shy of passing.⁵ This critical vote could happen next week and we need more lawmakers in Congress behind it.
