The first No Kings Day in June saw 5 million people turn out to protest Donald Trump's authoritarian abuses of power. Then in October, over 7 million people turned out for No Kings 2, making it one of largest single days of protest in the U.S. ever.¹

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Donald Trump and his MAGA allies have tried to smear the No Kings events as "Hate America" rallies because he knows the No Kings movement is a serious threat to his power.²

Authoritarians can only stay in power as long as the public believes that resistance is futile. Huge public displays of opposition like No Kings reveal that the facade of invincibility is an illusion.

In fact, research by Harvard University political scientist Erica Chenoweth finds that it only takes about 3.5% of the population actively participating in nonviolent protest to bring about major political reform.³ That's about 11.5 million Americans, and the No Kings protest in October saw 7 million people join in.

In other words, we're almost there.

With Trump's approval ratings falling in recent weeks to all-time second-term lows, he's doing everything in his power to suppress the opposition movements and institutions resisting his authority.⁴ He's become even more aggressive with militarizing city streets, attacking free speech, and wielding the power of the Justice Department against political enemies.

We will never back down, but it requires significant resources to recruit crowds to join 1,200+ events around the country.
